

## **Hanji retreat**

### **July 11–15, 2022**

5-day immersive workshop in a dedicated hanji studio taught by Aimee Lee. Easy to find corner storefront location with ample parking (4060 Mayfield Road, South Euclid, Ohio).

#### **Techniques covered**

- Understanding plants and fibers appropriate for making Korean-style paper
- Fiber prep: scraping, cooking, rinsing, picking, beating
- Webal sheet formation (suspended frame, professional tools: bal & bal teul)
- Ssangbal sheet formation (student tools)
- Pressing, boarding, drying paper
- Jiseung cords and basic twining
- Bark lace and joomchi

#### **Included in \$1,500 fee**

- Aimee's full-time instruction with assistant
- Prep starts at 9am, clean-up/wind-down starts 4pm each day
- Materials
- Catered lunch
- Handouts to share Aimee's extensive information on topics covered in class
- Use of studio tools/equipment during the week
- Access to Aimee's hanji library of books, samples, tools
- Small class size (4) to maximize learning time at webal vat
